Dear Family,

Greetings in Jesus! We rejoice for the day that we can see Him face to face. The Bible is our Facebook. We see Him in the pages, and we love what we see in part. Think about seeing Him, hugging Him, serving Him, and hearing Him in heaven.

We see in Matt. 23:23 that the scribes and Pharisees were good to tithe their mint, dill, and cumin; however, they completely missed the heart of the law, the weightier matters, the important necessary matters, and the crucial essentials of Godly living. They ignored the matters of the heart like justice, mercy, and faith. Jesus rebuked them with fire in His voice. We must examine what we are doing. How does what we do change others' eternity? What counts the most?

Jesus emphasized the PREACHING of the GOSPEL. His first words of PREACHING were in Mark 1:15... the kingdom of God is at hand; REPENT ye, and BELIEVE in the GOSPEL. His last words in Mark 16:15,16...GO into ALL the world, and PREACH the GOSPEL, to the WHOLE CREATION. 16. He that BELIEVETH and is BAPTIZED shall be SAVED... We see the weightier concerns of Jesus. Did the apostles and disciples pick up on the heart and purpose? I believe so. See Col. 1:23:...continue in the FAITH, grounded and steadfast, and not moved away from the hope of the GOSPEL, which ye heard, which was PREACHED in ALL CREATION under heaven. They did it! Let's do it, too!! Guard against having fruitless priorities! It is simply the Gospel that is #1!!

Roberto Alvarez reports from Guatemala that campaigns and weekend work resulted in 59 baptisms for July, 22 restorations, and 715 contacts. This includes the monthly evangelistic campaign in El Salvador which resulted in 18 baptisms and 7 restorations. Weekend work resulted in 41 baptisms and 15 restorations, plus 33 disciples for teaching others.

We have been hurting in the Honduras and Guatemala schools for funding. We are literally living hand to mouth. In the last two months, we have had to delay payments twice. Some good brethren have been so good to keep the wolf away for a short period of time. We need around \$3000/month more to meet our obligations. You have heard it said, "The main thing is to keep the main thing the main thing."

Arnoldo Lux reports 39 baptisms and 29 restorations for July in Honduras. Some of his information is not complete.

Dr. Erick Garcia, Director in Nicaragua, reports: campaign in El Almendro had 16 baptisms and 14 restorations; follow-up 8 baptisms, 3 restorations; weekends: 26 baptisms and 12 restorations; daily (weekdays): 7 baptisms, 4 restored; 10 other baptisms: total 67 baptisms with 33 restorations = 100 saved souls. All to God's glory.

Thank you for always keeping us in your prayers. It means everything to us. God bless all that you do.
